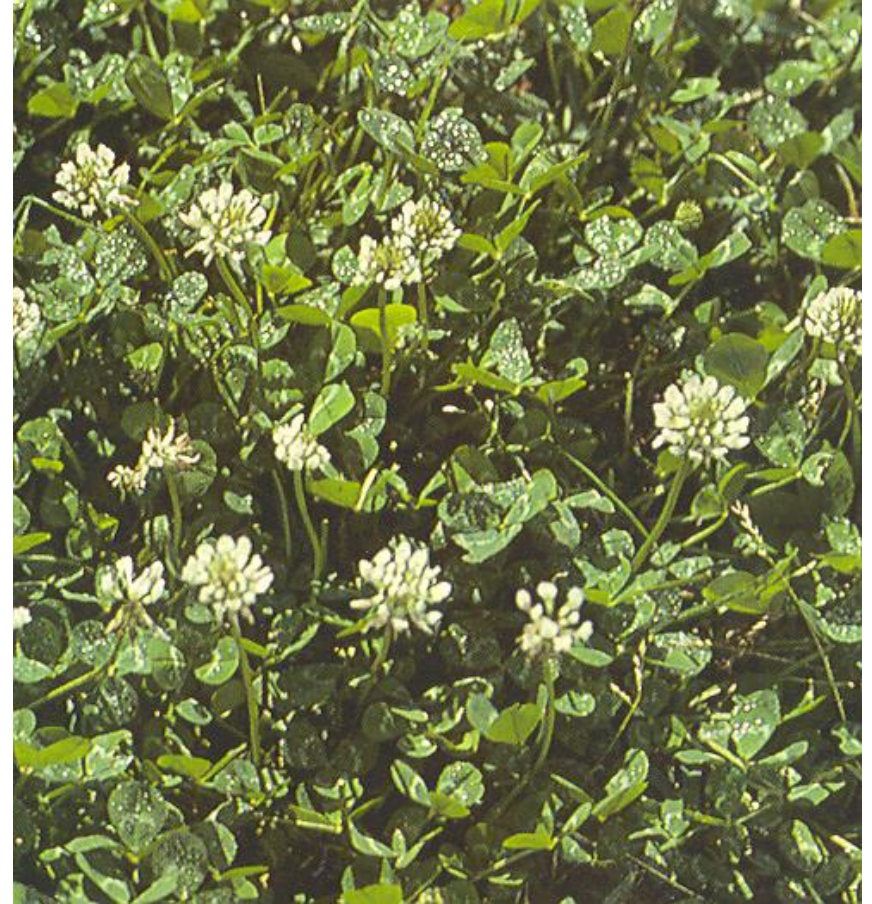


WHITE CLOVER



WHITE CLOVER

What to look for: 3 dark green leaflets, white/pinkish blossoms

Life cycle: Cool season perennial

Leaves: Dark green with white crescent; grow in groups of 3 with center leaf stalkless

Roots: From nodes of stems

Growth period: Spring, summer, fall

Treatment period: Post-emergent, whenever weed in actively growing



White Clover

- **Control Options:** Fiesta weed control is registered for effective control. Multiple treatments are recommended made at short intervals for best results.
- **Other:** White Clover is considered to be a difficult to control weed. Multiple applications are required season long to effectively control this weed even with synthetic weed control products
